

WASHER & DRYER INFORMATION

Troubleshooting Maintenance

If your unit is equipped with a washer and dryer, please make sure you are operating the machines correctly. Any repairs that are due to operator error are a resident charge.

If you are unsure how to do your laundry, please ask your roommate, parent, guardian, relative or friend and have them give you a quick lesson. Below are some helpful tips and instructions as well, or you can contact our office for additional help.



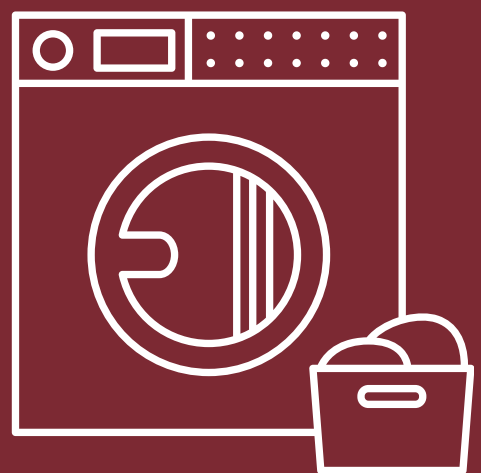
SORT YOUR LAUNDRY

Never mix light-colored items with dark or colored items. Don't wash heavy items (towels, blankets, jeans) with lighter clothes (shirts, slacks, socks) as this can cause the machine to become unbalanced. Make sure all pockets are empty before putting them into the washer. Rocks, coins, paper, lipstick, etc. can damage the machine.

DO NOT OVERLOAD

Make sure you are not putting too much in a single load. Overloading the machine can cause damage to the machine.

Place your load of laundry evenly inside the machine. Putting everything on one side of the washer will result in the machine becoming unbalanced. The machines need to be level in order for the cycle to work properly.



CLEAN THE LINT TRAP

Be sure to clean out the dryer lint trap before each load. Not cleaning it before each load will damage the dryer and has the potential to cause a fire.
